

HB 2528 -- ALTERNATIVE INSTRUCTION PLANS

SPONSOR: McDaniel

Beginning in school year 2019-20, this bill allows school districts to implement an alternative instruction plan approved by the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education for up to 10 days of school canceled due to inclement weather. The days in which a district uses an alternative instruction plan shall count as days of actual pupil attendance for purposes of state aid.

This bill is similar to HB 1506 (2018).
