1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 189, Page 1, Section A, Line 3, by  
2 inserting after said section and line the following:

4 "311.020. The term "intoxicating liquor" as used in this chapter shall mean and include  
5 alcohol for beverage purposes, alcoholic, spirituous, vinous, fermented, malt, or other liquors, or  
6 combination of liquors, a part of which is spirituous, vinous, or fermented, and all preparations or  
7 mixtures for beverage purposes, containing in excess of one-half of one percent by volume. The  
8 term "intoxicating liquor" shall include "powdered alcohol", which means alcohol that is prepared in  
9 a powdered, crystalline, or capsule form either for direct use or for reconstitution; "powdered  
10 alcohol" shall also include gum or candy infused with powdered or other alcohol. All beverages  
11 having an alcoholic content of less than one-half of one percent by volume shall be exempt from the  
12 provisions of this chapter[, but subject to inspection as provided by sections 196.365 to 196.445].";
