AN ACT

To amend chapter 610, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to expungement of certain marijuana offenses.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 610, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 610.133, to read as follows:

3 **610.133. 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law, if a person has been convicted**
4 **after December 31, 1997, and before August 28, 2019, of the offense of possession of**
5 **marijuana in an amount of thirty-five grams or less, the court has an affirmative duty to**
6 **expunge such conviction from all official records.**

7 **2. Notwithstanding any provision of law, beginning August 28, 2019, any person**
8 **convicted of the offense of possession of marijuana in an amount of thirty-five grams or**
9 **less shall have such conviction expunged. All official records to be expunged by the court**
10 **under this subsection shall occur the day the person is convicted.**
