1 **WHEREAS**, Freedom's Frontier National Heritage Area tells the stories of the settlement
2 of the frontier, the border and Civil Wars on the western frontier, and the enduring struggle for
3 freedom; and

4

5 **WHEREAS**, Congress established Freedom's Frontier National Heritage Area in 2006
6 to make the nationally-significant stories of this region better known to its citizens and the nation
7 as a whole; and

8

9 **WHEREAS**, More than 265 museums, historic sites, and economic development
10 organizations exist within the Freedom's Frontier National Heritage Area; and

11

12 **WHEREAS**, In 2018, Freedom's Frontier National Heritage Area received \$365,000 in
13 federal funds and \$827,000 in additional funding; and

14

15 **WHEREAS**, Freedom's Frontier National Heritage Area spent \$903,000 on
16 programming for the museums and historic sites within its boundaries; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Freedom's Frontier National Heritage Area is one of 49 national heritage
19 areas designed to create a unique public-private partnership to support the telling of nationally-
20 significant stories:

22 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the members of the House of
23 Representatives of the One Hundredth General Assembly, First Regular Session, hereby urge

24 Congress to reauthorize Freedom's Frontier National Heritage Area with the passage of HR 1049,
25 or other national heritage area program legislation.

27 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of
28 Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for the
29 members of the Missouri congressional delegation.
