1 AMEND House Joint Resolution No. 77, Pages 1-2, Section 4(b), Lines 1-19, by deleting all of said  
2 section and lines from the resolution; and

3  
4 AMEND House Joint Resolution No. 77, Page 2, Section 11(b), Lines 1-14, by deleting all of said  
5 section and lines from the bill; and

6  
7 Further amend said resolution and page, Section 11(g), Lines 1-10, by deleting all of said section  
8 and lines and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

9 "Section 11(g). 1. The school board of any school district whose operating levy for school  
10 purposes for the 1995 tax year was established pursuant to a federal court order may establish the  
11 operating levy for school purposes for the district at a rate that is lower than the court-ordered rate  
12 for the 1995 tax year. The rate so established may be changed from year to year by the school board  
13 of the district. Approval by a majority of the voters of the district voting thereon shall be required  
14 for any operating levy for school purposes equal to or greater than the rate established by court order  
15 for the 1995 tax year. The authority granted in this section shall apply to any successor school  
16 district or successor school districts of such school district.

17 2. Subsection 1 of this section shall no longer be effective after the effective date of an  
18 operating levy equal to the rate at which such school district would receive the same amount of  
19 property tax revenue from its operating levy that such school district received in the 2018 tax year.  
20 An operating levy ballot measure for the school district described in subsection 1 of this section  
21 shall be placed on a ballot to be considered by the voters of such school district before December  
22 31, 2021.

23 Section B. Under chapter 116 and other applicable constitutional provisions and law of this  
24 state allowing the general assembly to adopt ballot language for the submission of this joint  
25 resolution to the voters of this state, the official summary statement of this legislation shall be as  
26 follows:

27 "Shall the Constitution of Missouri be amended to:

- 28 - Allow for a limit to the amount by which real property assessments may increase; and  
29 - Authorize the Kansas City Public School district to maintain its property tax revenue for school  
30 purposes while moving the taxpayers of the district under taxpayer protections of Article X of the  
31 Constitution of Missouri?"; and

33 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
34 accordingly.
