2 Page 43, Section 173.2712, Line 15, by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "174.281. Southeast Missouri State University is hereby designated and shall hereafter be
5 operated as an institution with a statewide mission in the visual and performing arts, computer
6 science, and cybersecurity.

7 174.453. 1. Except as provided in section 174.450 and in subsection 6 of this section, the
8 board of governors shall be appointed as follows:

9 (1) Five voting members shall be selected from the counties comprising the institution's
10 historic statutory service region as described in section 174.010, except that no more than two
11 members shall be appointed from any one county with a population of less than two hundred
12 thousand inhabitants;

13 (2) Two voting members shall be selected from any of the counties in the state which are
14 outside of the institution's historic service region; and

15 (3) One nonvoting member who is a student shall be selected in the same manner as
16 prescribed in section 174.055.

17 2. The term of service of the governors shall be as follows:

18 (1) The voting members shall be appointed for terms of six years; and

19 (2) The nonvoting student member shall serve a two-year term.

20 3. Members of any board of governors selected pursuant to this section and in office on May
21 13, 1999, shall serve the remainder of their unexpired terms.

22 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 1 of this section, the board of governors of
23 Missouri Southern State University shall be appointed as follows:

24 (1) Six voting members shall be selected from any of the following counties: Barton,
25 Jasper, Newton, McDonald, Dade, Lawrence, and Barry provided that no more than three of these
26 six members shall be appointed from any one county;

27 (2) Two voting members shall be selected from any of the counties in the state which are
28 outside of the counties articulated in subdivision (1) of this subsection;

29 (3) One nonvoting member who is a student shall be selected in the same manner as
30 prescribed in section 174.055; and

31 (4) The provisions of subdivisions (1) and (2) of this subsection shall only apply to board
32 members first appointed after August 28, 2004.

33 5. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 1 of this section, the board of governors of
34 Missouri Western State University shall be appointed as follows:

35 (1) Five voting members shall be selected from any of the following counties: Buchanan,
36 Platte, Clinton, Andrew, and DeKalb provided that no more than three of these five members shall

1 be appointed from any one county;

2 (2) Two voting members shall be selected from any of the counties in the state which are
3 outside of the counties articulated in subdivision (1) of this subsection;

4 (3) One nonvoting member who is a student shall be selected in the same manner as
5 prescribed in section 174.055; and

6 (4) The provisions of subdivisions (1) and (2) of this subsection shall only apply to board
7 members first appointed after August 28, 2005.

8 6. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 1 of this section to the contrary, the
9 board of governors of Southeast Missouri State University shall be appointed as follows:

10 (a) One voting member shall be selected from one of the following counties: Butler,
11 Dunklin, Mississippi, New Madrid, Pemiscot, Scott, and Stoddard;

12 (b) Two voting members shall be selected from any of the following counties: Bollinger,
13 Cape Girardeau, Madison, Perry, Ste. Genevieve, and St. Francois;

14 (c) Two voting members shall be selected from any of the following counties or areas:
15 Franklin, Jefferson, Lincoln, St. Charles, St. Louis, St. Louis City, and Warren;

16 (d) Two voting members shall be selected from any of the counties in the state; and

17 (e) One nonvoting member who is a student shall be selected in the same manner as
18 provided in section 174.055.

19 (2) The provisions of paragraphs (a) through (c) of this subdivision shall only apply to board
20 members first appointed after August 28, 2020."; and
