1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 725,
2 Page 3, Section 21.855, Line 62, by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

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4 "37.850. 1. The commissioner of administration shall maintain the Missouri accountability
5 portal established in executive order 07-24 as a free, internet-based tool allowing citizens to demand
6 fiscal discipline and responsibility.

7 2. The Missouri accountability portal shall consist of an easy-to-search database of financial
8 transactions related to the purchase of goods and services and the distribution of funds for state
9 programs; all bonds issued by any public institution of higher education or political subdivision of
10 this state or its designated authority after August 28, 2013; all obligations issued or incurred
11 pursuant to section 99.820 by any political subdivision of this state or its designated authority; and
12 the revenue stream pledged to repay such bonds or obligations; and all debt incurred by any public
13 charter school.

14 3. The Missouri accountability portal shall be updated each state business day and
15 maintained as the primary source of information about the activity of Missouri's government.

16 4. Upon the conducting of a withholding or a release of funds, the governor shall submit a
17 report stating all amounts withheld from the state's operating budget for the current fiscal year, as
18 authorized by Article IV, Section 27 of the Missouri Constitution which shall be:

- 19 (1) Conspicuously posted on the accountability portal website;
20 (2) Searchable by the amounts withheld or released from each individual fund; and
21 (3) Searchable by the total amount withheld or released from the operating budget.

22 5. Every political subdivision of the state, including public institutions of higher education
23 but excluding school districts, shall supply all information described in subsection 2 of this section
24 to the office of administration within seven days of issuing or incurring such corresponding bond or
25 obligation. For all such bonds or obligations issued or incurred prior to August 28, 2013, every such
26 political subdivision and public institution of higher education shall have ninety days to supply such
27 information to the office of administration.

28 6. Every school district and public charter school shall supply all information described in
29 subsection 2 of this section to the department of elementary and secondary education within seven
30 days of issuing such bond, or incurring such debt. The department of elementary and secondary
31 education shall have forty-eight hours to deliver such information to the office of administration.
32 For all such bonds issued or debt incurred prior to August 28, 2013, every school district and public
33 charter school shall have ninety days to supply such information to the department of elementary
34 and secondary education. The department of elementary and secondary education shall have forty-
35 eight hours to deliver such information to the office of administration.

36 7. The following entities shall report for all employees of the entity their name, salary data,

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1 and incentive pay in the same manner as all state departments and agencies under this section:

2 (1) The county employees' retirement system established in sections 50.1000 to 50.1300;

3 (2) The sheriffs' retirement system established in sections 57.949 to 57.997;

4 (3) The Missouri local government employees' retirement system established in sections
5 70.600 to 70.755;

6 (4) The Missouri state employees' retirement system established in section 104.320;

7 (5) The Missouri department of transportation and highway patrol employees' retirement
8 system established in section 104.020;

9 (6) The prosecuting attorneys' and circuit attorneys' retirement system established in
10 sections 56.800 to 56.840;

11 (7) The college and university retirement plan established in sections 104.1200 to 104.1215;

12 (8) The Kansas City public school retirement system established in sections 169.270 to
13 169.400;

14
15 (9) The Kansas City civilian police retirement system established in sections 86.1310 to
16 86.1640;

17 (10) The Kansas City police retirement system established in sections 86.900 to 86.1280;

18 (11) The public education employees' retirement system established in sections 169.600 to
19 169.710;

20 (12) The public school retirement system established in sections 169.010 to 169.130;

21 (13) The St. Louis public school retirement system established in sections 169.410 to
22 169.540;

23 (14) The St. Louis firemen's retirement system established in sections 87.125 to 87.370;

24 (15) The St. Louis police retirement system established in sections 86.200 to 86.366; and

25 (16) The judicial retirement system established in sections 476.450 to 476.690."; and
