FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Transportation** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight notes that the Department of Transportation has stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight notes it is unclear which agency will enforce the requirements of this proposal. Oversight notes that railroad owners and operators shall provide the equipment and training required. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact to state and local governments on the fiscal note.

Oversight also assumes most railroad owners and operators will be compliant with the new requirements; therefore, Oversight will not reflect revenue from associated fines from this proposal.

The proposed legislation appears to have no direct fiscal impact.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
