1           **WHEREAS**, the Missouri House of Representatives recognizes the importance of  
2 educating youth about the legislative process; and

4           **WHEREAS**, the Missouri House of Representatives believes in empowering youth to  
5 become informed and engaged citizens; and

7           **WHEREAS**, the Missouri House of Representatives has a long tradition of rendering  
8 assistance to organizations that aim to educate and empower youth:

10           **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that we, the members of the Missouri House  
11 of Representatives, One Hundredth General Assembly, hereby grant the Missouri 4-H permission  
12 to use the House Chamber on Thursday, May 28, 2020, from 12:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

14           **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the sponsor of this House Resolution,  
15 Representative Kelley, or her designee, shall be present in the House Chamber and shall assume  
16 responsibility for the group's actions for the duration of the aforementioned event.

18           *Special note:* Participants in the aforementioned event shall conduct themselves in a manner that  
19 preserves the dignity and honor of the House of Representatives. Such persons shall behave  
20 respectfully and dress appropriately for the occasion. Food items, drinks, and smoking are  
21 prohibited on the floor of the House and lower gallery, and participants shall refrain from any  
22 conduct that diminishes the decorum of the House Chamber.

24 Access to the dais is limited to the Speaker's podium for purposes of using the microphone to  
25 speak to those assembled. Access to the staff area behind the rostrum is prohibited.

27 Group photographs; the hanging of any banners or other items on the walls, curtains, or any  
28 surface within the House Chamber; and the use of any equipment, including computers, phones,  
29 or other items on the dais and rostrum area, are also prohibited.
