

HB 1604 -- RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS

This bill amends the restriction that commissioned and civilian personnel who were previously employed by the Board of Police Commissioners be required, throughout their employment for the City of St. Louis, to retain a primary residence in the City of St. Louis for a total of seven years before being permitted to maintain a residence outside the City of St. Louis as long as the residence is located within a one-hour response time. This bill specifies that, commissioned and civilian personnel currently employed by the board will not be subject to a residency restriction so long as the employee's primary residence is located within a one-hour response time.
