

HB 2246 -- BOARD OF PUBLIC BUILDINGS

SPONSOR: Bailey

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Corrections and Public Institutions by a vote of 8 to 0.

This bill allows the Board of Public Buildings to meet in the seat of government as well as any other location in the state, and any member may attend a meeting in person, via videoconferencing, or any other electronic means, provided that any meeting complies with meeting provisions of the Missouri Sunshine Law.

This bill is the same as SB 831 (2020).

PROPOSERS: Supporters say that this bill provides a technology update to meetings for the board by allowing video conferencing.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Bailey.

OPPOSERS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
