1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill Nos. 85 & 310, Page 4, Section 1.460, Lines 1-6, by  
2 deleting all of said lines and inserting in lieu thereof the following:  
3

4 "1.460. 1. Any political subdivision or law enforcement agency that employs a law enforcement  
5 officer who acts knowingly, as defined under section 562.016, to violate the provisions of section 1.450 or  
6 otherwise knowingly deprives a citizen of Missouri of the rights or privileges ensured by Amendment II of  
7 the Constitution of the United States or Article I, Section 23 of the Constitution of Missouri while acting  
8 under the color of any state or federal law shall be liable to the injured party in an action at law, suit in equity,  
9 or other proper proceeding for redress."; and  
10

11 Further amend said bill and page, Section 1.470, Lines 1-3, by deleting all of said lines and inserting in lieu  
12 thereof the following:  
13

14 "1.470. 1. Any political subdivision or law enforcement agency that employs an individual acting as  
15 an official, agent, employee, or deputy of the government of the United States, or otherwise acting under the  
16 color of federal law within the borders of this state, who knowingly, as defined under section 562.016:"; and

18 Further amend said bill and section, Pages 4-5, Lines 9-31, by deleting all of said lines and inserting in lieu  
19 thereof the following:

21 "shall be subject to a civil penalty of no less than fifty thousand dollars per occurrence.

22 2. Any person residing or conducting business in a jurisdiction who believes that an individual has  
23 taken action that would violate the provisions of this section shall have standing to pursue an action for  
24 declaratory judgment in the circuit court of the county in which the action allegedly occurred or in the circuit  
25 court of Cole County with respect to the actions of such individual.

26 3. If a court determines that an individual has taken any action in violation of the provisions of this  
27 section, the political subdivision or law enforcement agency that employs such individual shall be required to  
28 pay the court costs and attorney's fees associated with the declaratory judgment action that resulted in the  
29 civil penalty."; and

31 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references accordingly.
