1 AMEND Senate Substitute for Senate Bill No. 22, Page 1, Section A, Line 4, by inserting after all of  
2 said section and line the following:

4 "34.700. 1. Performance audits for economy and efficiency shall be conducted at least once  
5 every four years on each of the state departments, the legislature, the judiciary, and departments and  
6 offices under the executive branch including, but not limited to, the office of administration, the  
7 governor, the lieutenant governor, the attorney general, the secretary of state, the state auditor, and  
8 the state treasurer.

9 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of 34.010 to the contrary, the office of administration  
10 shall solicit bids and select an independent auditor as provided by this chapter.

11 3. Within thirty days of receiving the results of the audit, the entity shall post the results on  
12 its website.

13 4. The office of administration shall submit the results of each audit to the general assembly.

14 5. Any entity that fails to participate in the audits required under subsection 1 of this section  
15 shall be subject to suit for declaratory judgment and injunctive relief, brought by the attorney  
16 general in the circuit court of Cole County. The entity shall not have use of the attorney general's  
17 legal services for such suits and shall be required to retain its own counsel."; and

19 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
20 accordingly.
