1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 922, Page 1, Section A, Line 2, by
2 inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "162.012. 1. For purposes of this section, the following terms mean:

5 (1) "School-sponsored activity", any activity sponsored by a school including, but not
6 limited to, participation in a work-based learning program in which training or work activities are
7 conducted at the premises of or under the direction of an employer participating in the program;

8 (2) "Work-based learning program", the same meaning given to the term in section 170.038.

9 2. The school board of any school district may purchase insurance contracts to insure
10 against loss, damages, or expenses incident to a claim arising out of the sickness, bodily injury, or
11 death by accident of any student injured on school premises or during school-sponsored activities.
12 For purposes of this subsection, travel to and from any work-based learning program shall constitute
13 a school-sponsored activity.

14 3. The school board of any school district may purchase insurance contracts for the benefit
15 of students to insure against loss resulting from the loss of, theft of, or damage to the personal
16 property of students while on school premises or during school-sponsored activities.

17 170.038. 1. For purposes of this section, the following terms mean:

18 (1) "Secondary education", education of students who attend secondary schools;

19 (2) "Secondary school", a public school giving instruction in a grade or grades not lower
20 than the sixth nor higher than the twelfth grade;

21 (3) "Work-based learning program", a learning program in a secondary education
22 curriculum that:

23 (a) Includes, but is not limited to, work study, on-the-job training, job shadowing,
24 internships, clinicals, practicums, cooperative projects, and industry-led service-learning projects;

25 (b) Is incorporated into coursework or related to a specific field of study; and

26 (c) Integrates knowledge and theory learned in the classroom with the practical application
27 and development of technical skills and proficiencies in a professional work setting.

28 2. An employer who accepts a secondary school student in a work-based learning program
29 shall not be subject to civil liability for any claim arising from the student's negligent act or
30 omission.

31 3. Nothing in this section shall provide immunity for gross negligence or willful
32 misconduct."; and
