1 AMEND House Amendment No. \_\_\_\_\_ to House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 814,  
2 Page 1, Line 29, by inserting after all of said line the following:

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4 "Further amend said bill, Page 3, Section 67.2815, Line 67, by inserting after all of said line the  
5 following:

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7 "70.631. 1. Each political subdivision may, by majority vote of its governing body, elect to  
8 cover emergency telecommunicators, jailors, and emergency medical service personnel as public  
9 safety personnel members of the system. The clerk or secretary of the political subdivision shall  
10 certify an election concerning the coverage of emergency telecommunicators, jailors, and  
11 emergency medical service personnel as public safety personnel members of the system to the board  
12 within ten days after such vote. The date in which the political subdivision's election becomes  
13 effective shall be the first day of the calendar month specified by such governing body, the first day  
14 of the calendar month next following receipt by the board of the certification of the election, or the  
15 effective date of the political subdivision's becoming an employer, whichever is the latest date.  
16 Such election shall not be changed after the effective date. If the election is made, the coverage  
17 provisions shall be applicable to all past and future employment with the employer by present and  
18 future employees. If a political subdivision makes no election under this section, no emergency  
19 telecommunicator, jailor, or emergency medical service personnel of the political subdivision shall  
20 be considered public safety personnel for purposes determining a minimum service retirement age  
21 as defined in section 70.600.

22 2. If an employer elects to cover emergency telecommunicators, jailors, and emergency  
23 medical service personnel as public safety personnel members of the system, the employer's  
24 contributions shall be correspondingly changed effective the same date as the effective date of the  
25 political subdivision's election.

26 3. The limitation on increases in an employer's contributions provided by subsection 6 of  
27 section 70.730 shall not apply to any contribution increase resulting from an employer making an  
28 election under the provisions of this section.

29 4. The provisions of this section shall only apply to counties of the second or third  
30 classification, any county of the first classification with more than sixty-five thousand but fewer  
31 than seventy-five thousand inhabitants and with a county seat with more than fifteen thousand but  
32 fewer than seventeen thousand inhabitants, and any county of the first classification with more than  
33 seventy thousand but fewer than eighty-three thousand inhabitants and with a city of the fourth  
34 classification with more than thirteen thousand five hundred but fewer than sixteen thousand
