1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 785, Page 3, Section 8.178, Line 8, by
2 inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "590.1150. 1. Prior to January 1, 2022, the attorney general shall create a database to
5 coordinate the sharing of information between state, local, and federal law enforcement agencies
6 concerning instances of excessive use of force related to law enforcement matters, accounting for
7 applicable privacy and due process rights.

8 2. The database described in subsection 1 of this section shall include a mechanism to track,
9 as permissible, terminations or decertifications of peace officers, criminal convictions of peace
10 officers for on-duty conduct, and civil judgments against peace officers for improper use of force.
11 The database shall account for instances in which a peace officer resigns or retires while under
12 active investigation related to the use of force. The attorney general shall take appropriate steps to
13 ensure that the information in the database consists only of instances in which peace officers were
14 afforded due process.

15 3. The attorney general shall regularly and periodically make available to the public
16 aggregated and anonymized data from the database described in subsection 1 of this section, as
17 consistent with applicable law.

18 590.1152. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, if any peace officer is convicted of or
19 pleads guilty or nolo contendere to a crime involving the unlawful use or threatened use of physical
20 force, or is found civilly liable for the use of unlawful physical force, the POST commission shall
21 revoke the peace officer's certification under this chapter. The POST commission shall not reinstate
22 the peace officer's certification or grant new certification to the peace officer unless the peace officer
23 is exonerated for such offense by a court. The POST commission shall record each decertified
24 peace officer in the database created under section 590.1150."; and

26 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
27 accordingly.
