ASSUMPTION

§§376.394 and 376.1753 - Health carriers and MO HealthNet to cover certain midwife services

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety, Missouri Highway Patrol (DPS/MHP)** defer to the **Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT)** for the potential fiscal impact of this proposal.

Oversight notes DPS/MHP’s deferral to MoDOT for a statement of fiscal impact; for fiscal note purposes, Oversight assumes no fiscal impact for DPS/MHP.

Officials from the **Department of Commerce and Insurance, the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Department of Social Services, the Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan, the Missouri Department of Conservation and the Missouri Department of Transportation** have each stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these organizations.

The proposed legislation appears to have no direct fiscal impact.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.


