AN ACT

To repeal section 67.080, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to expenditures of political subdivisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 67.080, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 67.080, to read as follows:

67.080. 1. The expenditure orders, motions, resolutions, or ordinances approved or adopted and filed as provided herein, and the transfers made as provided herein, shall constitute the authorization for the expenditure of money for the budget year. No expenditure of public moneys shall be made unless it is authorized as provided herein.

2. **Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, no political subdivision or special district shall automatically renew any contract, including employment contracts, without taking a definite action to renew the contract, and no political subdivision or special district shall act to renew a contract earlier than three months prior to the expiration of the contract. Each contract shall be renewed independently, and the renewal of one contract shall not guarantee, obligate, or affect the renewal of any subsequent or contingent contract including, but not limited to, instances in which a political subdivision or special district has multiple contracts with one entity. Any contract renewed in violation of this subsection shall be null and void.**
