## AN ACT

To repeal section 556.037, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the time limitations for prosecuting certain sexual offenses.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 556.037, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 556.037, to read as follows:

556.037. 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 556.036, prosecutions for:

2           **(1) Unlawful sexual offenses involving a person eighteen years of age or under; or**

3           **(2) Felony sexual offenses involving any person**

5 may be commenced at any time.

6           2. For purposes of this section, "sexual offenses" include, but are not limited to, all

7 offenses for which registration is required under sections 589.400 to 589.425.
