

# HOUSE BILL NO. 401

### AN ACT

To amend chapter 376, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to epinephrine auto-injectors.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 376, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 376.1223, to read as follows:

**376.1223. 1. Each health carrier or health benefit plan that offers or issues health benefit plans that are delivered, issued for delivery, continued, or renewed in this state after December 30, 2021, shall offer coverage for epinephrine auto-injectors for children under nineteen years of age as prescribed by a physician, advanced practice registered nurse, or assistant physician acting within the scope of his or her practice.**

**2. For purposes of this section, "epinephrine auto-injector" shall have the same meaning given to the term in section 196.990. "Health carrier" and "health benefit plan" shall have the same meanings given to the terms in section 376.1350.**

**3. Such coverage shall not be subject to any deductible or co-payment limits.**

**4. The provisions of this section shall not apply to a supplemental insurance policy, including a life care contract, accident-only policy, specified disease policy, hospital policy providing a fixed daily benefit only, Medicare supplement policy, long-term care policy, short-term major medical policies of six months' or less duration, or any other supplemental policy as determined by the director of the department of commerce and insurance.**
