AN ACT

To amend chapter 9, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to overdose awareness day.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 9, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 9.318, to read as follows:

9.318. 1. August thirty-first each year is hereby designated as "Overdose Awareness Day" in Missouri. Citizens of this state are encouraged to recognize the day with appropriate events and activities about the dangers of drug use, addiction, and overdose.

2. All agencies and political subdivisions of this state shall fly the United States flag at half-staff in recognition of all those lost to an overdose.
