

HB 185 -- INAUGURAL ACTIVITIES

SPONSOR: Ellebracht

This bill creates a filing and disclosure system for committees funding inauguration activities for anyone elected to statewide office.

The bill requires a statement of organization to be filed with the Missouri Ethics Commission within 30 days after the Committee is formed. The statement requirements are specified in the bill.

The Committee must file a disclosure report with the Ethics Commission that itemizes receipts, expenditures, and indebtedness incurred by the Committee. The first report must be filed within 30 days after the statement of organization is filed and every three months thereafter, as specified in the bill. Records shall be retained for three years after termination of the Committee.

This bill is the same as HB 1374 (2020).
