

HJR 23 -- RIGHT TO HUNT AND FISH

SPONSOR: Black (137)

Upon voter approval, this proposed Constitutional amendment guarantees the right of hunters and anglers in the state to engage in hunting, fishing, or harvesting wildlife using traditional means. Public hunting and fishing shall be a preferred means of wildlife management and control. The amendment does not prevent the General Assembly from enacting laws that limit the rights of convicted violent felons or those deemed by a court to be a danger as a result of a mental disorder or mental infirmity.
