Officials from the Department of Corrections, the Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol, the Missouri Department of Transportation, the Missouri Office of Prosecution Services, the Office of the State Courts Administrator, the Office of the State Public Defender, the City of Kansas City, the City of Springfield, the Kansas City Police Department, the St. Louis County Police Department, and the Phelps County Sheriff's Department each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other police and sheriff's departments and the cities of Columbia and St. Louis were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
