#### **FISCAL ANALYSIS**

#### **ASSUMPTION**

§565.002 – Special victim

Officials from the **Department of Corrections (DOC)** state this involves a small population and specialized circumstances. Therefore, it is expected to have no significant impact on the DOC.

Officials from the **Office of the State Public Defender (SPD)** state the proposed legislation expands the definition of a special victim, under Section 565.002, and therefore, could increase the number of persons who are eligible for representation by State Public Defender (SPD). The fiscal impact of this legislation on SPD is unknown as the number of additional cases eligible for representation as the result of the legislation is unknown, but it is anticipated that any increase would be less than \$250,000.

**Oversight** notes in FY22 the SPD was appropriated moneys for 53 additional FTE. Oversight assumes this proposal will create a minimal number of new cases and that the SPD can absorb the additional caseload required by this proposal with current staff and resources. Therefore, Oversight will reflect no fiscal impact to the SPD for fiscal note purposes. However, if multiple bills pass which require additional staffing and duties, the SPD may request funding through the appropriation process.

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety – Missouri Highway Patrol**, the **Missouri Office of Prosecution Services**, and the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.
