FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Missouri Senate** anticipate a negative fiscal impact to the joint contingent appropriation to reimburse 6 members of the General Assembly for travel to committee meetings. In summary, it will cost approximately \$776.16 per meeting.

Officials from the **Missouri House of Representatives** state the joint contingent appropriation will cover any reasonable expenses incurred by our members serving on the committee; therefore, no fiscal impact.

Oversight assumes the proposal would not create a material fiscal impact to the state.

Officials from the **Department of Natural Resources** and the **Joint Committee on Legislative Research** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Oversight notes that the above mentioned agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.
