HB 1465 -- PRODUCTION OF VACCINATION DOCUMENTATION

SPONSOR: Schnelting

This bill specifies that no entity within the state may require documentation of vaccination status to access public transportation systems. The bill also prohibits any governmental entity from issuing vaccine passports in order to share with a third party or otherwise publish a person's vaccination record. Businesses in the state would also be prohibited from requiring a customer to provide documentation of COVID-19 vaccination or immunity in order to gain entry to, or services from, the business.

Any business that fails to comply with these provisions would lose eligibility for grants or contracts funded by state revenue.

However, these provisions would not restrict a business from instituting COVID-19 screening protocols in accordance with state and federal law in order to protect public health.
