

HB 1735 -- DAYLIGHT SAVING AS NEW STANDARD TIME PACT

SPONSOR: O'Donnell

This bill established the "Daylight Saving as New Standard Time Pact" to consist of Missouri and any other state seeking to permanently change Daylight Saving time to a new standard time. All areas of the state are exempted from daylight saving provisions of federal law.

In the year in which two states bordering Missouri have passed legislation entering those states into the Pact, each state will permanently switch their clocks to Daylight Saving, Daylight Saving Time will be eliminated, and Missouri and all other participating states will no longer observe Daylight Saving Time.

This bill is the same as HB 822 (2021).
