

HB 2210 -- ELECTRONIC LITERARY PRODUCTS

SPONSOR: Hurlbert

This bill provides that a publisher who offers to license electronic literary products, as defined in the bill, to the public shall also offer to license such products to public libraries. Publishers shall offer to license such products to public libraries on reasonably similar terms as those offered to the public.

The terms of a license shall not include a limitation on the number of product licenses a public library may purchase on the same date such license is made available to the public, or on any later date.

A violation of the provisions of this bill shall constitute unfair, abusive, or deceptive trade practice and is subject to enforcement in accordance with Sections 407.005 to 407.145, RSMo.
