## HJR 132 -- CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS (Kidd)

Upon voter approval, this proposed Constitutional amendment requires that any Constitutional amendment must receive both a majority of statewide votes and a majority vote in more than one-half of the State House of Representative Districts in order to become effective.

These requirements would also apply to Constitutional changes or amendments proposed during a Constitutional convention held under article XII, section 3(c) of the Constitution of Missouri.

The resolution contains ballot language submitted by the General Assembly under Chapter 116, RSMo.
