In 2020, Missourians sent nearly 6.9 million tons of solid waste to landfills for disposal, yet our state's landfill capacity is dwindling with several landfills expected to close within the next 10 – 20 years. The formation of this joint committee will provide the opportunity to examine key areas with Missouri's recycling infrastructure and explore opportunities to invest and improve on waste diversion from landfill disposal through organics recycling, education, market development for recyclables, and extended producer responsibility initiatives.
