HB 257 -- TEACHER RETIREMENT SYSTEM

SPONSOR: Pollitt

Currently, a retired teacher or a retired noncertificated employee who is receiving a retirement benefit from the Public School Retirement System of Missouri is allowed to work full time for up to two years for a school district covered by such retirement system if the system has a shortage of certified teachers or noncertificated employees. This bill allows these employees to work full time up to four years for such districts.

This bill is similar to HB 1881 (2022) and HB 812 (2021).
