As the largest and oldest anti-poverty non-profit in our state, Empower Missouri is committed to improving the quality of life for all Missouri residents through advocacy. Since our inception, Empower Missouri has focused on the criminal justice system and its impacts. Our Community Justice Coalition consists of community advocates and organizations from across the state who work with those who have been impacted by the criminal justice system. Many coalition members are formerly incarcerated or have currently incarcerated loved ones, and all are connected by a vision for a future without mass incarceration. We are providing testimony today in support of HB 1133, sponsored by Representative Chad Perkins, which would award time served credit for any days spent incarcerated in jail pre-trial. Jail credit, also known as "credit for time served" refers to time spent in jail while awaiting trial. This time can be used to lower the amount of time someone must serve in prison or jail once they have received a jail or prison sentence. For example, say a person is arrested for a misdemeanor and spends two days in jail before they are released. At trial, they are sentenced to ten days in jail and a fine. Since they have already spent two days in jail while they were awaiting trial, those two days can count towards the ten days they are required to serve, even though they had not been sentenced at that time. Currently, unless a judge awards time credit for time served before the conviction, an individual incarcerated in jail is not receiving credit that can count towards a future sentence. The current process penalizes those who cannot afford bail and must remain incarcerated in jail awaiting trial. Additionally, Missouri counties can charge the state reimbursement for a person's incarceration, but that same person is not entitled to jail credit unless a judge says so. By enacting HB 1133, Missouri would ensure that all individuals held in jail pre-trial receive time served credit for that period of incarceration. Empower Missouri urges this committee to take action to pass HB 1133 into law. Thank you for your time and consideration of this matter.
